Sunday, October 10: Depart from Newport, Mifflintown & Lewistown. Comfort & Meal Stops enroute to hotel. Arrive and check in at the Fairfield Inn and Suites and enjoy dinner at the **APPLE TREE INN**.

Monday, October 11: After an included breakfast at the hotel, we will enjoy the **FALL FOLIAGE LEAF PEEPER TOUR** and visit the **NORMAN ROCKWELL MUSEUM**. Lunch will be on your own in **STOCKBRIDGE**, where Norman Rockwell lived and worked. Take time after your meal to visit the **RED LION INN** to see the antique teapot collection. Next, we will tour **THE MOUNT**, the home of Edith Wharton who was the first woman to receive the Pulitzer Prize. And we finish off the day with an included dinner at a local restaurant.

Tuesday, October 12: Following breakfast at the hotel, we will check out and depart for New Hampshire. Our first stop we will visit the **STERLING AND FRANCINE CLARK ART INSTITUTE**, then onto lunch at the **BENNINGTON APPLE BARN**. After our boxed lunch and **HOT APPLE PIE a la MODE**, we will take a narrated bus ride to the top of the 300-acre orchard to view the most spectacular scenery of Southern Vermont. Then we will return to shop in the country bake shop and enjoy the aromas of baked goods, pure maple syrup, preserves, cheese and **SO MUCH MORE....** Our final venue to tour for the day will be the **HEMMINGS AUOTMOBILA**, then onto our hotel the Mountain Club on Loon Resort where we will check in and enjoy a buffet dinner.

Wednesday, October 13: Following breakfast at the hotel, we will depart for **LAKE WINNIPESAUKEE** where we will board the **M/S MOUNT WASHINGTON** for a scenic ride to the town of **WOLFEBORO, NH**. In this delightful lakeside resort town, you will have lunch on your own and time to tour and shop. Next, we will head for a tour of the **WRIGHT MUSEUM** then onto a relaxing 2-hour ride and dinner on the **WINNIPESAUKE RAILROAD TURKEY DINNER TRAIN**.

Thursday, October 14: Following breakfast and checking out at the hotel, we will depart for **OLD STURBRIDGE VILLAGE**. Costumed interpreters demonstrate life in the early 1800s in more than 40 buildings, gardens and working farms. Lunch will be on your own in the village. In the afternoon, we will check into our hotel and enjoy the **ORIGINAL HISTORIC FIRESIDE FEAST** at the **SALEM CROSS INN**, which has the only known 1700's antique roasting jack.

Friday, October 15: Following breakfast at the hotel, we will depart for home remembering our Amazing Autumn Adventure in the Northeast. Comfort and meal stops will be enroute home.
