**Wednesday, April 14:** Pickups at Lewistown, Mifflintown & Newport. Comfort stops enroute. Arrive at the **New National Museum of The United States Army** and enjoy lunch on your own while visiting. Depart for the **Holiday Inn & Suites at Virginia Beach**. Arrive and check-in then enjoy the remainder of the evening and dinner on the **Virginia Beach Boardwalk**.

**Thursday, April 15:** Following breakfast, we will depart for **Nauticus** which includes a series of interactive exhibits, 3D, high-def films in the 250-person theatre and aquariums of marine life. A true highlight of any visit to Nauticus is a self-guided tour of the **Battleship Wisconsin**, one of the famous Iowa-class ships. This great ship saw action in WWII, Korean War and most recently in the Persian Gulf War. Then onto lunch on your own at the **Waterside District Market**. After lunch we will visit the **MacArthur Memorial Museum** which is dedicated to preserving and presenting the story of the life of the General and those who served with him in WWI, WWII, and Korea. Next, we will visit the **Chrysler Museum** which contains over 50 galleries with 30000+ objects and an incredible glass studio. Then onto an all-inclusive dinner at the **Freemason Abbey Restaurant**. And to end the day will be the AMAZING performance of the **International Tattoo**, a spectacle of military splendor with bands, drill teams and so much more!



**Friday, April 16:** After breakfast at the hotel, we will head to the **Norfolk Botanical Gardens** to enjoy the 155-acre garden with the largest collections of azaleas, camellias, and rhododendrons on the East Coast. Then onto visiting **The National Museum of the Marine Corps**, a lasting tribute to the U.S. Marines – past, present, and future. Enjoy lunch on your own at **Devil Dog Diner** or **Tun Tavern**. We will then depart for **Quantico National Cemetery** where we will have the

opportunity to honor veterans by placing flags next to their graves. After paying respects, we will depart for home to share our experience with family and friends.
