**Monday, August 21 to
Friday, August 25, 2023**

Monday, August 21: Depart from Lewistown, Mifflintown, and Newport. Comfort and meal stops ‘on own’ enroute to hotel. Arrive and check in at the **Clarion Hotel Portland**. An all-inclusive buffet dinner will be enjoyed at the hotel.

Tuesday, August 22: After breakfast at the hotel, we depart for a tour of **historic Portland and lighthouse loop** including a photo stop at **Portland Head lighthouse**. Then **drive by Spring Point Lighthouse**, perched out in the harbor on a granite jetty and the nearby **Bug Lighthouse Park** on the grounds of a former shipyard with **WWII Liberty Ship Memorial**. Enjoy lunch on your own in **Freeport**. Sit back and relax for your afternoon drive through the mid-coast Maine region, dotted with glimpses of quiet coves and bustling harbor villages. In the lobster capital of the world – you’ll tour the **Maine Lighthouse Museum** to learn about the beacons that dot the rocky coast of Maine – and spot the Rockland Harbor Lighthouse guarding the entry to the harbor. Continue “downeast” along the coastal route and cross the causeway to **Mt. Desert Island**, named for its bare, desert-like mountaintops on the edge of the ocean. Check in to the **Acadia Inn** and roll up your sleeves and don your lobster hat for a **Maine lobster bake dinner** with all the fixin’s.

Wednesday, August 23: After breakfast we will depart for a **Bar Harbor Nature Cruise**. Enjoy some free time and lunch on your own at one of the many casual restaurants along the waterfront. Then onto a **narrated, afternoon tour of Acadia National Park**. Here in the first park founded east of the Mississippi. Highlights of this tour include the stunning Loop Road, the summit of Cadillac Mountain, the crashing waves at Thunder Hole and quiet beauty of the inland park scenery. Plated dinner is included Bar Harbor this evening, before making your way to unique entertainment at the **Great Maine Lumberjack Show**.

Thursday, August 24: After breakfast we will depart for **Kennebunkport**, where you will have lunch on your own, with many charming shops and eateries in Dock Square. Then board an oversized lobstering tour boat for a one-hour **Lobstering Cruise**. See the sights as you cruise on the ocean past Walkers Point, the ‘Dark Shadows House’ and Bumpkin Island. Next, we will check in at the **Ogunquit River Inn**. **NOTE: hotel is on multiple levels with NO elevator**. Another authentic **lobster bake** dinner is in store for you tonight. Enroute to dinner, stop for a photo of **Maine’s southernmost lighthouse**, the Nubble Light. **Sing-along entertainment** is included at this festive evening feast!
